PD Racer – the simplest cheapest BOAT

8ft x 4ft x 63lbs (2.4 x 1.2 x 29kg) – Special \$20

Up to 2 Adults and a medium dog

The PDR is a fast growing international class originally from the USA. Our OZ version PDRs have excellent sailing performance and feel like bigger boats on the water. Can take an outboard or be rowed.



Goat Island Skiff

15'6" x 5'6" x 128lbs hull (4.6 x 1.65 x 59kg)

Up to 4 Adults and a picnic – plans \$100

The "GIS" is my most popular plan. A strikingly handsome but very easy to build. It carries up to four adults and still sails extremely well – with one or two people aboard it has modern performance and will whop any "character boat". Takes a small outboard and rows nicely too.



Eureka Canoe

15'6" x 33" x 46lbs (4.6 x 0.84 x 21kg)

Up to two adults & camping gear – plans \$75

The Eureka is the closest you can get to a classic canoe shape in a plywood boat. Traditional shapes give the easiest paddling and just keep going when the water gets rough. The Eureka can be built down to weights of around 15kg (34lbs)



Handy Punt

11'6" x 4' x <100lbs (3.5 x 1.2 x <47kg)

Up to 3 adults and child – plans \$80

The Handy Punt is a simple punt. Stable for fishing it can take outboards up to 15hp, but 6 to 10hp is more normal! Narrow enough to rooftop so the towbar is free for the caravan.



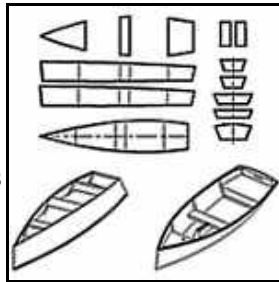
Light Weight

A light boat is easier and more fun to use. We really understand lightweight structures so our boats are often half the weight of similar types that you may see elsewhere. And we do this without sacrificing strength. It also makes them cheaper and faster to build - fewer parts! Our boats are often 50% lighter than others.



Easy Building

Our plans are step by step in most cases and include full instructions on how to use all the materials involved. As we understand boat structures so well we eliminate parts wherever possible. You will find the total number of parts involved in our boats can be half or a third of some similar designs.



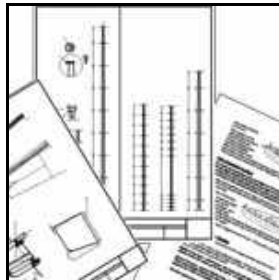
Excellent Performance

Take a boat that is light and strong and you can't stop it from being fast! Our boats might have a strong traditional character, but they don't behave that way. We like sailing fast boats - our "character boats" will sail, row and paddle rings around others. With our motor boats they have excellent performance with smaller motors and excellent fuel economy.



Detailed Plans

For a lot of years now people have been excluded from owning their own sailing boat because of the expense of conventional sailing boats. A child's boat like a Sabot will cost around \$6000 to get on the water – and adult boats are much worse.



In Conventional terms “REVOLUTION” usually means creating carbon fibre monsters – we laugh at their narrow thinking :-)

Cheap

The PD Racer is an international class boat that costs between \$300 to \$1000 to get sailing. This brings boats back into the reach of everyone.

Simple

The PDR is the simplest possible boat. There are only two curved lines – everything else is square making it easy for first time builders. There is a minimum of framing timber – all the load is carried in the plywood. The low number of parts make it exceptionally fast to build.

Fun to sail

But just because it is simple doesn't mean it is slow. The light weight, generous sail and detail design from modern dinghy design make it very lively on the water. It retains this good performance even with two adults aboard.

Experienced sailors tend to scoff at this little boat – until they take one for a sail! and find out just how much fun it is ...

... in fact we have found it very hard to get them back to shore so others can have a go! They bring out the child in everyone that steps aboard.
